Parent's Club Event Descriptions

<u>Pre-School Coffee and Kleenex-</u> This event gives parents of pre-schoolers an opportunity to stop by and meet other pre-school families right after drop off on the first day. Volunteers are needed to stop by and mingle.

Fun Lunch-One Friday a month, (usually the 3rd Friday), parents have the opportunity to order a catered lunch from Buona Beef for their child. Volunteers are needed to come into school on that day and help serve the food.

<u>Jr. High Dance/GymNight-</u> 3 times a year Parents Club puts on activities just for our Jr. High students. Volunteers are need to co-chair the event, set-up/decorate, clean-up, supervise, etc.

Fall Fest- Fall festis an opportunity to gather as school families and parishioners. Activities include food, games, face painting, bouncy houses, cake-walk, pie eating contest and much more. Volunteers are needed for set-up, clean-up, running games, baking cakes, food service, and more.
