# Queen of the Rosary Parents Club Meeting Wednesday, May 2, 2018 

A. Opening Prayer/Reflection: Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Dana Arciniegas, PC President, followed by an opening prayer led by Debbie Strohm.

## C. President's Report (Dana Arciniegas):

i. Mother/Daughter Event Recap: Chair Toni Wierig shared that the event, held on Saturday, April 21, went well and had a great turnout with 55 people.
ii. Junior High Volleyball Tournament: Organized by Lynn Rittle

1. This event was initially scheduled as a dance but turned into a volleyball tournament for $5^{\text {th }}-8^{\text {th }}$ graders instead.
2. Because of the good turnout and response, the format of two junior high dances and one sport event (volleyball, dodgeball, etc) will likely be held again next year.
iii. Art Appreciation
3. The program is continuing to see a decline in volunteers, and there is currently no one signed up to lead the program in May.
4. Dana Arciniegas will be looking for someone to chair an Art Appreciation committee to help boost participation for the next school year.
iv. School Box Tools
5. School supply lists from all the teachers have been received for the 20182019 school year.
6. For each box purchased, one meal will be donated to Feed My Starving Children.
7. There is also an option to increase the price of each toolkit, so $5 \%$ or $10 \%$ of the money received from School Box Tools would come back to QR.
a. There was discussion on this topic, and it was decided to look into whether or not a donation button of $5 \%$ or $10 \%$ could be listed giving parents the option to donate rather than raising the overall price of the kits.
v. Games Day: Scheduled for Friday, June 1.
8. The $7^{\text {th }}$ graders will participate in assisting with the game stations.
9. Miss Aulisio is looking into finding which games we have and what needs to be ordered.
10. More information and a volunteer sign up form will be coming out this week.
vi. Track-a-Thon
11. The Parents Club donation to this event will be juice boxes, as requested by the School Board.
12. Fun Lunch for May 18 is cancelled due to the Track-a-Thon.
vii. Parents Club Gift
13. Per last month's meeting, the group decided to purchase 12 new ukuleles for the music department, which would mostly benefit students in the upper grades.
14. There was also discussion about the other half of the gift going towards students in the lower wing, specifically through the outdoor classroom.

viii. End of Year Survey

2. The purpose is to find out what kinds of activities families would like to see and what can be done to help them get more involved.
