    - ii. Tomorrow, Thursday May 13, is the new parish feast day of Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament. There's a few things connected with that, which are described in my bulletin article from last Sunday.
    - iii. There are some updated COVID guidelines from the Archdiocese for our church celebrations. Most of them won't impact the average experience in the pew, but it's a good step towards a fuller reopening.
    - iii. We are in the beginning stages of planning a Corpus Christi procession that will take place after the 10:30am Mass on Sunday, June 6. We would process from QR to St. Julian with the Blessed Sacrament, and the kids who made their first communion will be invited to join the procession in their 1st communion outfits. More details soon.
    - iv. We're planning on temporarily consolidating the parish offices to the St.

Julian location. That move will happen the week of May 23rd, and both parish offices will be closed for the week. We'll reopen after Memorial Day. There's also some FAQs in the bulletin about the decision, so I encourage everyone to take a look at that.
