Dear Parent/Guardian,

If you are registering a student new to the school- **preschool or any other grade**- you will need to email Mrs. Bowman to request new student paperwork. A few of our classrooms are near capacity so timely registration is important. All current families who are returning next year are asked to turn in the non-refundable reregistration form and fee (\$125.00) **on or before Thursday, January 25**. Submitting your re-registration ensures a spot for your child/ren. **Open registration, registration for new families/new students, will begin on Sunday, January 28**.

- If a student athlete is not in school he/she may not play in a game or practice on any day that he/she is not in school.
- If the school has a weather related or emergency closing, no after school practices or games may take place.
- Any student attending games needs to be accompanied by an adult and is expected to be in the gym watching the games and not in the lobby. Appropriate behavior is expected at all times.
- All coaches and assistant coaches must complete all Virtus volunteer requirements (www.qrschool.org Parent Tab/ Volunteer). In addition, the online concussion training needs to be taken and the certificate turned in to school.
- Eligibility will be run weekly for players in grades 5-8. If a student is placed on supervision, he/she may practice and play. However, a student who is placed on suspension may not play or practice.

EMERGENCY SCHOOL CLOSING INFORMATION

In the event of an emergency school closing, usually due to weather conditions, you will be notified by our **School Messenger System**, which notifies you with a message from the principal on your home/cell phone. The following radio and television stations will be notified: WGN-720 AM, WBBM-780 AM, CBS-Channel 2, NBC-Channel 5, ABC-Channel 7, WGN-Channel 9, and FOX-Channel 32. Also, refer to the Emergency Closing Center online at https://www.emergencyclosingcenter.com to search for Queen of the Rosary's closing.

A weather—related closing by School District 59 will be used as a guide in determining the closing of Queen of the Rosary School. However, if District 59 is closed and Queen of the Rosary is open, there will be no bus transportation.

In the communication, information will be provided indicating if the day is a snow day or an e-learning day.
