### Virtus Compliance-

Annual Audit- The school goes through an annual audit with the Office of Catholic Schools to make sure all volunteers, coaches, and employees are in compliance with Virtus. This takes place this month, and all volunteers who are listed as ACTIVE need to be in compliance. I am asking any volunteers who are active and not compliant to please complete the process by October 11. Anyone who is not fully compliant by the October 11 date will be made inactive, and can't be active/volunteer/coach until after our audit is complete, which won't be until mid-late November.
