Dear Parent/Guardian,

Curriculum Night is tonight, August 24. The teachers and I look forward to all families joining us tonight for this informational evening. The doors open at 6:15 p.m. Please park in the back lot and use door 7, the door by the kitchen, to enter. This is an evening for adults.

For the safety of all students, dogs are not allowed on the parking lot, playground or grassy area during arrival or dismissal.

Mark your calendars for Tuesday, Sept. 12, for an event for our grandparents. We will be inviting grandparents to attend morning Mass with us and then to come back to the school. (Sorry Moms and Dads, this is only for grandparents.) Information and details to come next week.
